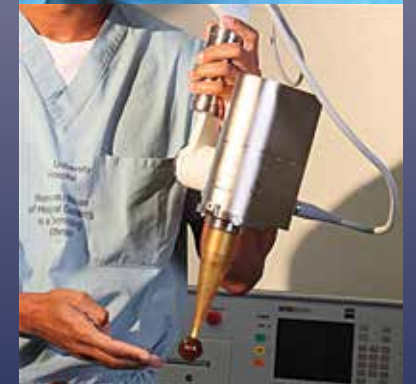
CONFERENCE PROGRAM
